Today's Music

Rise 'n' Shine is an African-American spiritual that comes out of the Second Great Awakening, that revival of religious fervor of the 19th-century. Many of the spirituals of this time share lyric content and Rise 'n' Shine has been shown to share text with Keep Yo' Lamps Trimmed and Burnin' and Jacob's Ladder. These all speak to a sense of perseverance in the face of adversity and a firm belief in the inherent goodness of God. The beauty of this spiritual comes from Psalm 150, which directly exhorts us to sing before the Lord with joyful song because our Creator is the ultimate arbiter of Truth and we are His. The rising figures of this arrangement recall a maxim of the African-American church, 'When praises go up, blessings come down'; it is in this joyful spirit that we offer this gift to our Father.
